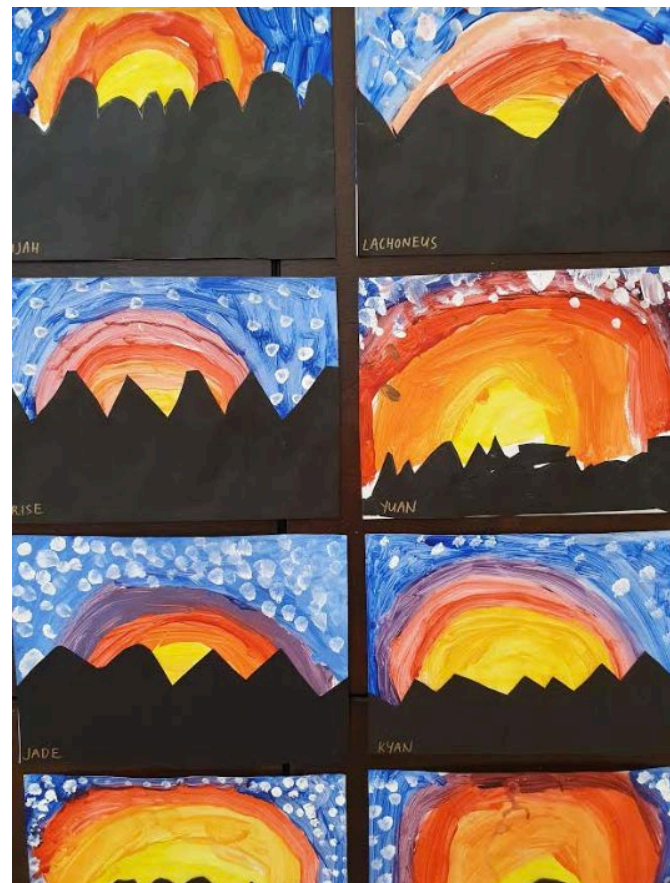
### From the PTA
